**SALT CITY BASSMASTERS COMPETE ON BLACK LAKE, CARDINALE AND
CANESTRARE SHARE TOP HONORS, GRADY THIRD.**

Kith Cardinale and Dave Canestrare shared a boat and the winner's spotlight as they bested the thirty four angler field with identical 14 lb 6 oz limits June 28th on Black Lake. Keith returned to Salt City Bassmasters after a three year break to gather his first club victory. Dave also earned his first victory in just his second year with the club. The pair fished two spots on the day, fishing weightless five inch plastic worms in five to seven feet of water. They concentrated on specific areas with scattered rock and weeds that were holding fish. They caught fish all day with some of the best bites coming after noon.

Third place went to Patrick Grady with a five fish limit that went 12 lbs 4 ozs. Patrick caught his fish on black hand poured

worms and top water frogs in two to five feet of water. Lunker went to Eric Barker who brought in a 3 lb 12 oz largemouth on a black and blue one half ounce jig and pig on a sharp drop off.

The tournament anglers enjoyed a great early summer day of mostly sunny skies, light and variable winds, calm water and 73 degree surface water temperatures.
